

In Search of Paradise

GREAT GARDENS OF THE WORLD

Overview *In Search of Paradise: Great Gardens of the World* presents photomurals of the world's great gardens by the world's preeminent garden photographers together with text by internationally known garden writer Penelope Hobhouse.

The Chicago Botanic Garden offers this exhibition as a license of intellectual property, and will work with each renting institution to select the images and text panels best suited to its needs. Each venue is responsible for producing the photomurals at the size and format (small/large; framed/unframed; indoor/outdoor, etc.) it desires.

Space Requirements Varies depending on package chosen.

Cost Base fee is \$5,000, which includes: high-resolution RGB digital files for the exhibition title panel, introduction and acknowledgement panels, and up to 10 photomurals with related section introduction and interpretive panels. Each additional photomural and its accompanying identification panel is \$500.

Contents The exhibition as presented at the Chicago Botanic Garden contains the following:

(1) Exhibition introduction:	48" x 30" panel
(1) Exhibition acknowledgements:	48" x 30" panel
(1) Exhibition logo:	8" x 72" photomural
(11) Theme introductions:	48" x 30" panels
(21) Interpretive panels:	48" x 30" panels
(72) photomurals:	48" x 72" with 18" x 12" label panel

Each photomural is identified by a label panel. Labels provide the garden name, date, designer, location, photographer, and a 75–90 word description.

Theme Packages Packages include: Water in Historic and Contemporary Garden Design; Materials and Ecology in Contemporary Garden Design; Urban Gardens; Individual Vision; Contemporary Garden Design; Gardens of the Future; Tropical, Desert, or Mediterranean Gardens.
