Overview *In Search of Paradise: Great Gardens of the World* presents photomurals of the world's great gardens by preeminent garden photographers with text by internationally recognized garden historian Penelope Hobhouse.

Rental fee \$500 per piece with a seven-piece minimum for a three-month period.

All rentals include the exhibition logo photomural, exhibition introduction, and acknowledgments panel. Discounts are available if renting more than one theme.

Themes & photomural count Asian Gardens (7), Ecological Gardening (7), English Gardens (7), European Gardens (7), The Garden of Cosmic Speculation by Charles Jencks (10), Individual Vision (7), Materials Matter (7), Middle Eastern & Desert Gardens (9), Modern Gardens (10), Nature in the City (7), North American Gardens (7), Tropical Gardens (6), Water Gardens: A View to the Past (10), and New Ways with Water (8).

Space requirements Varies depending on theme selected, ranging from 65 to 370 linear feet.

Shipping Venue is responsible for one-way shipping within the U.S.; international arrangements vary.

Components Photomurals with individual labels and interpretive panels with text and images. Photomurals vary in number based on the theme.

Theme introduction panels present the overarching ideas for each section. Interpretive panels present more details and illustrative images.

Each garden photomural is identified and interpreted with an individual label. These labels provide the garden name, date, designer, location, photographer, and a 75-90 word description.

Security Low; public access to the building needs to be monitored.

Exhibition catalogue A hardcover exhibition catalogue with text by Penelope Hobhouse and more than 200 full color images, published by Frances Lincoln, London, is available through U.S. distributors. It retails for \$45.
