

Course: Black and White Stippling Workshop

Required materials:

Instructor will supply specimens, but if you prefer: bring a potted plant that you really like;), with fairly large leaves, strong pattern is fine; draw at life size (if possible) before class

- Pelikan drawing ink A, black, fresh; or other fresh black ink you have from pen and ink class
- Daler-Rowney F&W acrylic ink, white
- Round watercolor brush, good quality synthetic, # 4 or 3 (should have good point)
- Crow quill pens:
Speedwell Hunt crow quill dip pen holder, and crow quill dip pen nibs, two, #102, Pigma Micron black pen, .005
- Small container about the size of 35mm film canister
- Tracing paper pad, approx 11" x 14"
- sketch pad
- HB drawing pencil
- Pencil sharpener
- Tape
- Kneaded eraser
- White illustration board or 5 ply paper, hot press, OR your favorite heavy-weight pen and ink
- surface; approx. 11" x 14" (to fit your plant)
- Small water container
- Eyedropper
- Tissues
- Sponge or rag

*scratchboard will be provided at cost-- please contact instructor ahead of time

*for scratchboard only: exacto knife

*scratchboard is not the primary focus of the class but it has much in common with black and white stipple, and it will be demonstrated briefly. Students may choose to work in scratchboard, which is very appropriate to furry subjects. Please contact Marlene ahead of time if you are interested so that enough material will be available.
