

Course: Botanical Drawing 1

Required Materials:

Please bring to the first session

- Spiral bound sketchbook approx 8 ½ x 11" (if you are in the certificate program, you will use this as your "illustrated notebook" throughout the program)
- Paper: 14 x 19" (or larger) newsprint pad (or other inexpensive paper), Canson Classic Cream Drawing pad at least 9 x 12"
- Pencils, B and 2B
- Kneaded eraser
- Bottle to use as a vase

These supplies will be discussed in first class

- Pencils, wood or mechanical with 2 mm leads: 2H, B, 2B, 4B, 6B
- Pencil sharpener
- Erasers, kneaded and Tuff Stuff Eraser Stick
- Tracing paper, 11" x 14"pad
- Good quality acid free drawing paper: EITHER Canson Classic cream, Strathmore Bristol (plate or vellum surface), or Fabriano hot press watercolor paper, 140lb
- Dividers, inexpensive drafting tool, looks like compass with no lead
