

**Course:** Color Mixing 2

**Required Materials:**

Supplies listed are for watercolor. Students may work in PASTEL or COLORED PENCIL if preferred; in that case please bring the paper of your choice and a set of pastels or pencils that includes a warm and a cool in each of the primary colors and a range of values. Please contact instructor with questions.

**Watercolor supplies:**

Professional quality watercolor paints in tubes: Winsor Newton, Daniel Smith, Graham, or Holbein, No student colors such as Cotman, please. Ask art store staff to help with pigment numbers (e.g. PY 175) if necessary. Pigment numbers are important because color names vary among manufacturers. Numbers are in fine print on the back of the paint tube.

**Required:**

- Winsor Yellow, PY 154, 15 mil tube
- New Gamboge, PY153
- Winsor (Thalo) Green, blue shade PG 7
- Burnt Sienna (all professional brands okay)
- Permanent Rose, PV 19
- Scarlet Lake (Winsor Newton), same as Organic Vermillion (Daniel Smith), PR188
- Ultramarine blue PB 29 (Winsor Newton—NOT Daniel Smith which is very grainy)
- Cerulean Blue (several possible numbers—all seem okay)
- Brushes: good quality synthetic round watercolor brush, # 8

**Paper:**

- 1 full sheet Fabriano cold-pressed watercolor paper, 140 lb, cut or torn into quarter sheets
- Spiral bound sketchbook or scrapbook approx 9" x 12" (for notebook)

**Misc.:**

- Two containers for water
- Bottle that can be used as a vase
- Sponge
- Pencils, HB and B
- Non-porous Drawing board (Gatorboard is ideal)
- ½ inch drafting tape
- Kneaded eraser
