

Course: Form and Texture in Watercolor

Required Materials:

- Transparent Watercolors: *One tube each, *Winsor Newton* Brand Winsor Lemon Winsor Yellow Deep French Ultramarine Blue Cerulean or Cobalt Blue Alizarin Crimson Permanent Cadmium Red (warm red)
- Round Brush: Size 2 or 3 Raphael, Series 8404 This is a sable brush that makes a fine point for detail.
- Papers **1 sheet 300 lb. *hot press Fabriano Artistico* watercolor paper, (cut in quarters)
- Scrap watercolor paper for testing colors
- Tracing paper
- Daler Rowney Acrylic Artists Ink, White
- Small white plastic palette for mixing colors 10 wells, round with plastic cover
- ***Clear Plexiglas approximate size 8" x 10"
- Eye dropper for picking up water
- Kneaded Eraser
- Artist Low-tack Tape
- 2 Containers for Water (Small Yogurt Containers)
- Paper Towels
- Paper for writing notes
- Pencil

**I prefer the 300 lb paper, however 140 lb will work. Hot press is a must. Please do not substitute with Arche brand paper.

***Pick this up at your local hardware store - ask for scrap pieces. This makes a really wonderful dry brush palette. Using your artists white tape or masking tape, tape a piece of white paper (just regular computer paper) to the bottom of the plexiglass. We will spread paint on to the plexiglass (not the paper side), and let it dry for dry brush work.

^{*}If you already have watercolors, please bring what you have.
