- 1" blade palette knife

Canvases, either canvas panels or stretched canvases

 One 6" x 8" and three or four others from the sizes of 8" x 10", 9" x 12", and 12" x 16" **the smaller the work, the quicker we can solve painting problems. (If you are experienced, please feel free to work larger)
