Course: Microscope and Botanical Dissection workshop

Required Materials:

- In class you will be drawing flower parts and the dissections of flowers. You may bring a sketchbook and or tracing paper or whatever papers you would like to draw on. These could later be put in a sleeve in a binder for future referral.
- Bring any colored pencils that you have for color reference and to delineate flower parts.
- Graphite drawing pencils 2B, B, HB, 2H (bring pencils you like to draw with-these are suggested)
- Pencil sharpener
- (or if you have a lead holder and the leads 2B, B, HB, 2H and lead pointer available at drafting supply stores)
- Kneadable eraser
- White magic rub or similar white eraser
- Divider (Shaped like a compass w/ 2 sharp points instead of one)

Optional:

- Hand lens, loupe or magnifiers (10x)
- Ott Lite to illuminate your drawing surface
