Course: Outdoor Sketching

Required Supply List:

- Small drawing board & spring clips (2)
- Watercolor papers or pads (approximately 9 x 12")
- Sketchbook or sketchpad (your choice of portable size)
- Graphite drawing pencils (HB, 2B, 3B)
- Colored Pencils (your choice of professional grade in a good range of color and value)
- Suggestions: Prismacolor, Caran d'Ache, Derwent, Faber-Castell, Lyra
- Watercolor Pencils (your choice of professional grade in a good range of color and value)
- Suggestions: Derwent's Inktense, Prismacolor, Faber-Castell
- Prismacolor Verithins (your choice in a good range of color and value)
- Hand held pencil sharpener
- Factic Black 18 eraser (General Pencil Co.)
- Synthetic, inexpensive brushes (small & medium, flat & round)
- Water container (small plastic with lid)
- Paper towel (a few sheets) or rag

Optional:

- Materials you like to use (watercolor or gouache, non-permanent ink pens, etc.)

For a nominal fee, the instructor can supply extra surfaces (Strathmore, Stonehenge, Wallace, toned papers, etc.) for students use.

Weather permitting; the class will be drawing outside. Please bring whatever you need to make yourself comfortable. That could include a small chair or stool, sunhat, small table, clothing in layers, a waterbottle. Folding chairs will be available for student use. An easel is not necessary.
