

**Course:** Pen and Ink 2

**Required materials:**

- 1 layout pad - Bienfang Designer Series #360 (\*11" x 14" or 14" X 17") or similar.
- Bristol Board - 3 Sheets of 2 Ply 23" x 29" (Plate Finish).

Please make sure each sheet has an embossed stamp that reads Strathmore 500 Bristol. Please fold each sheet in half to 23" x 14.5" for convenience - please try and keep perfectly flat and in mint condition.

- Pencils (2 of each), 2H, H & HB
- 1 One Kneaded Rubber Eraser
- 1 Bottle of black Indian Ink (waterproof)
- 1 Bottle of Sepia Indian Ink (waterproof)
- 2 Dip Pen/crow quill holders (one of which should be for the smaller crow quill nib).
- 2 Dip Pen nibs/crow quill) – one of each: Hunt's #512, Hunt's Extra Fine #22, and Hunt's mapping pen nib #103
- The use of a Rapidograph Pen or a Micron Pen may be preferred and is perfectly acceptable for discretionary use.
- A Drawing Board is highly recommended as 'good drawing practice'.
