**Course:** Landscapes in Pastel

**Required Materials:**

A full range of values in pastels is more important than a huge range of colors, so rather than buying a large set I recommend a basic set supplemented by individual sticks so that you have a minimum of the following:

- 5-10 values of each of the primary colors (red, yellow, blue)
- 5-10 values of each of the secondary colors (orange, green, violet)
- 5-10 values of each of the tertiary colors (red-orange, yellow-orange, yellow-green, blue-green, red-violet, blue-violet)
- 5-10 values of earth colors (browns, both warm and cool, and sand or beige colors)
- 5-10 values of neutrals, both warm and cool (gray-blue, gray-violet, gray-green, etc.)
- 1 soft white

For reasons of economy, try a fairly large set of Nupastels supplemented by Rembrandt individual sticks. Other good brands include Girault (my personal favorite), Schminke and Sennelier (both very soft) and Unison. It is best if pastels are organized according to value.

- Sketchbook
- gray markers in three values: light gray, medium gray and black
- Pastel pencils if you already have them
- Pencils
- $\frac{3}{4}$  inch or 1 inch drafting tape
- Light drawing board at least 10 x 13 inches
- Tracing paper pad 11" x 14", both for drawing and for storing paintings

**For a nominal fee the instructor will supply paper.**
