Enjoy a buffet dinner in one of our private rooms with a view! Our menu is sure to please your group. Then, make sure to work up an appetite for dancing!

#### **6pm to 9pm – *Hot Summer Nights***

Unwind during *Hot Summer Nights* and learn a new move or two! Professional dance instructors will be on hand during select weeks to provide visitors with easy-to-understand mini lessons that will correspond to the genre of the evening.
