

Course: Botanical Drawing 3

Required Materials:

- Professional quality drawing paper:
Good quality drawing paper of your choice; toned paper is fine if you prefer. We will be creating study pages.
- Spiral bound sketchbook approx 8 ½ x 11" (if you are in the certificate program, you will use this as your "illustrated notebook" throughout the program)
- 14 x 19" (or larger) newsprint pad, or other inexpensive pad paper, for warm-up exercises
- Tracing paper, 11" x 14" pad
- Pencils, 2H, B, 2B, 4B and 6B
- Wolff Carbon Pencils, 2B and 6B (or 4B if you can't find 6B). Ritmo or Primo charcoal pencils can also be used.
- Sand Pad (for sharpening Wolff pencils)
- Kneaded eraser
- Plastic water bottle or other fairly tall container for vase
- Dividers, inexpensive (drafting tool, looks like compass with no lead)
- Flat synthetic brush (inexpensive), about ¼ inch
- White pastel pencil (Pitt Pastel, Medium or Soft is fine) for use with toned paper
- Tape
- Pencil sharpener

There will be a small fee (at cost, \$5 or less) for instructor provided materials.
