**Course:** Color Mixing

**Required Materials:**

Professional quality watercolor paints in tubes: Winsor Newton, Daniel Smith, Graham, or Holbein, Some colors are specified as to brand. **No student colors such as Cotman, please.**

Ask art store staff to help with pigment numbers (e.g. PY 175) if necessary. Pigment numbers are important because color names vary among manufacturers. Numbers are in fine print on the back of the paint tube.

**Please bring all paints, palette etc. to the first class.**

- Winsor Yellow, PY 154, 15 mil tube
- Winsor Yellow Deep, PY 65
- Viridian, PG 18, 15 mil tube
- Burnt Sienna, Winsor Newton PR101 or Pb 7, Holbein
- Permanent Rose, PV 19
- Scarlet Lake (Winsor Newton), same as Organic Vermillion (Daniel Smith), PR188
- Ultramarine blue PB 29 (Winsor Newton—NOT Daniel Smith which is very grainy)
- Cerulean Blue PB 35

**Brushes:**

- good quality synthetic round watercolor brush, # 8

**Paper:**

- ½ sheet Arches cold-pressed watercolor paper, 300lb, can be purchased at cost from instructor
- 1 full sheet Arches cold-pressed watercolor paper, 140 lb., cut or torn into quarter sheets
- Spiral bound sketchbook or scrapbook approx. 9" x 12" (for notebook)

Misc.:

- Mixing palette, not divided; porcelain butcher tray (if flat enough) or white Corelle Ware dinner plates (from Ace hardware or Target)
- Two containers for water
- Bottle that can be used as a vase
- Sponge
- Pencils, HB and B
- Small pad tracing paper
- Drawing board
- ½ inch masking tape
- Kneaded eraser
