Required Materials:

- Drawing Board
- 2 Spring Clips
- Stonehenge paper, white (cut into 4 – 11 x 15")
- Good quality watercolor paper (Arches 140# cold press)
- White scrap paper
- Tracing vellum (2-3 sheets, used as slip sheet)
- Watercolor pencils: your choice in a full color and value range (suggested brands: Derwent Inktense, Prismacolor, Caran d'Ache Supracolor Aquarell, Faber-Castell Albrecht Durer)
- Colored pencils: your choice in a full color and value range (suggested brands: Prismacolor, Caran d'Ache Pablo, Derwent, Faber-Castell, Lyra)
- Prismacolor Verithins in a full color and value range
- Inexpensive synthetic brushes: large, medium, and small flats and rounds
- Water container (small)
- Paper towels or rags
- 2B and HB Graphite Pencil
- Hand Held Pencil Sharpener
- General Pencil Co. - Factus Black 18 Eraser
- Fine grit sand paper sheet
