

LARGE GARDEN PLAN


60 x 100 FEET



Make successive plantings of vegetables to insure a continuous supply. As soon as one vegetable is harvested, clear the row and plant another crop. Do not plant the

same vegetable in a row twice. In general, root vegetables should be alternated with leafy vegetables.







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
