

Course: Color Pencil Drawing Course

Required Materials:

- **<u>Drawing Paper</u>**: We will talk a lot about paper so do not over-buy unless you are sure of your preferences. The instructor will have samples.
 - 1. Come with good quality watercolor paper or drawing paper. Hot Press preferred, 140# weight, white (brands include Fabriano Artistico, Arches). Stonehenge paper 90# weight is often used for colored pencil drawing.
 - 2. Sketch pad such as Canson XL Series Mixed Media 98# white paper (9" x 12" or larger) spiral bound sketching pads. This paper has some "tooth."
 - 3. Tracing paper

Artist Quality Colored pencils:

Minimum: 10 to 12 basics, including dark red, bright red, yellow, cerulean blue, darker blue, light green, dark green, purple, umber, cream, and a soft gray (brands: Faber-Castell, Prismacolor, Caran d'Ache, Derwent, Lyra)

Optional extra, but strongly recommended: *Prismacolor Verithins

• Artist Quality Watercolor pencils:

At least 6 - 8 basic colors (brands: Derwent Inktense, Prismacolor, Caran d'Ache Supracolor Aquarell, Faber-Castell Albrecht Durer)

- Blender pencil- colorless pencil (very important)
- Pencil Sharpener
- <u>Erasers:</u> Selection of white plastic (Faber Castell, Staedtler Mars)
- Watercolor brushes: Bring what you have. Synthetics and "water pens" are fine.
- <u>Tape</u>: Artists' tape (white, narrow) and Scotch tape (important, for lifting)

• Miscellaneous:

Water container (small)
Paper towels and/or soft paper napkins
Magnifying glass
Sand paper sheets or emery boards
Graphite pencils
