Course: Coloring Monarchs and Milkweeds

Required Materials: **Please bring to the first class**

In this class, students can use colored pencil, or a few more media such as graphite pencil, watercolor pencil, watercolor, water-soluble pencil, and ink. Using just colored pencil is perfectly fine. Bring whatever you would like to try.

Any brands recommended?

While students can use anything they already have, instructor recommends some, in case of buying new ones.

1. Graphite pencils (in case students want to try with pencil): Caran d'Ache, Faber-Castell, Staedtler, Derwent, or similar good quality pencils): 2H, F, HB, B, 2B
2. Colored pencil: a basic set (16 or 18) will be fine, but more color will make colored page more sophisticated. Prisma color, or Faber-Castell,
3. Watercolor Pencil set: instructor's favorite brand: Caran d'Ache
4. Brush: needed only with water soluble media. One soft watercolor brushes, pointed round, size 3 or 4.

One very convenient brush for outdoor sketch is Faber Castell Delux Water Brush

5. Paper: illustrated line drawings will be provided, but students need a few pieces of paper for practice or trying techniques. Regular print paper or a sketch book will be good.
6. Other materials: kneaded eraser, regular plastic eraser, pencil sharpener, sand paper or Emory board, scotch tape
