

Course: **Expressive Watercolor Workshop**

Required Materials:

- Plastic water container
- paper towels
- #4H, #4B pencils
- Small Sketchbook, 5x7
- kneaded eraser

- palette with mixing area and wells
- viewfinder for composition
- masking tape
- cut sponge or natural sponge
- camera
- Any landscape, nature or botanic photos you have taken

Brushes:

- 1" flat
- #36 round
- #7 round

Papers:

(1) Sheet of 22" x 30" 300 lb. Arches cold press watercolor paper or equivalent

Paints: Winsor/Newton or equivalent e.g. Daniel Smith, Richeson's etc

ultramarine blue (sometimes called French ultramarine)

- cadmium yellow light
- viridian green
- cerulean blue
- alizarin crimson

- cobalt blue
- cadmium red light
- yellow ochre

Please feel free to bring any additional watercolor supplies or paint colors you like and may have acquired from previous watercolor classes and workshops.
