Course: Open Studio

Students should bring supplies related to the project they are currently working on. The instructor recommends the Drawing 2 supply list as a good place to start if you are unsure.

Botanical Drawing 2 supply list:

- Spiral bound sketchbook approx 8 ½ x 11"
- Paper: 14 x 19" (or larger) newsprint pad, or other inexpensive pad paper
- Canson Classic Cream Drawing pad at least 9 x 12"
- Tracing paper, 11" x 14" pad
- Pencils, 2H, B, 2B, 4B and 6B
- Charcoal Pencils, HB or B and 3B, either Ritmo or Primo brand.
- Sand Pad (for sharpening charcoal pencils)
- Kneaded eraser
- Plastic water bottle or other fairly tall container for vase
- Dividers, inexpensive (drafting tool, looks like compass with no lead)
- Flat synthetic brush (inexpensive), about ¼ inch
- White pastel pencil (Pitt Pastel, Soft or equivalent)
- Tape

These supplies will be discussed in first class:

- Pencil sharpeners
- Tuff Stuff Eraser Stick
- Good quality acid free drawing paper: EITHER Canson Classic cream, or Strathmore Bristol (vellum surface) ideally 500 series
