

**Course:** Pen and Ink 1

**Required materials:**

1. Basic drawing materials for preparatory drawing:

- \* a few pencils (2H, H, B), eraser, pencil sharpener

2. Ink:

- \* Winsor & Newton black Indian ink (with a spider man graphic on the package)  
This ink is shiny, truly black, and waterproof. Do not buy 'calligraphy ink'.

3. Pen nibs:

- \* Hunt (Speedball) #512 and pen holder
- \* Hunt (Speed ball) # 102 & 103 and pen holders (a pen holder for each nib recommended)

4. Paper:

- \* Strathmore Bristol Board, Plate, 140Lb (2-ply),

One or two sheets will be needed for each class.

- \* Bienfang 360 Graphic Marker for preparatory drawing and tracing.

5. Others:

- \* Drawing board: Any board that can firmly hold drawing paper (A tip: two identical light weight foam boards serve perfectly as a drawing board, and keep paper safely in between while traveling.)
- \* Specimen holder (frog pin holder, a small jar, etc.), a small water jar for washing pen nib)
- \* Divider, ruler, a role of paper towel
