**Course:** Principles of Garden Design

**Required Materials:**

- Sketchbook, approximately (8.5" x 11") and spiral bound
- Pencils; 2H, HB, and 2B
- Trace paper; roll, 18" wide, white or buff colored
- 12" roll of trace paper (in addition to the 18")
- Roll of masking tape
- Drafting triangles, 30/60 degree and 45 degree
- T-square, 24" length minimum
- Drafting scale, architectural and engineering
- Red and black sign pens or Sharpies
- Colored pencils or markers for rendering

\*Additional supplies may be required and will be discussed in your first session.
