Course: Watercolor 2

Required Materials: Please bring to the first class

- A masking fluid pen - either fine tip or medium tip (found at Michael's, Blick, Amazon, Cheap Joe's (online), and Artorama (online))
- A drawing pencil – HB (medium soft) or 2B (soft)
- A kneaded eraser
- Paper – a pad of water color paper with a medium egg shell roughness (not too rough or too smooth).
- Water Color Paint – one small tube each of the following colors:
 1. Lemon yellow
 2. French ultramarine blue
 3. Alizarin crimson
- Brushes- 1 inch (or a bit larger) flat watercolor brush for washes
 1. 2 or 3 more brushes varying in size (round)
 2. An old tooth brush

You do not have to spend a lot of money on expensive brushes, just make sure they are water color brushes and not meant for oil or acrylic paints. Avoid sable brushes. I like Japanese bamboo brushes. They are inexpensive, and you can get a variety of brush marks from them.

- Palette – You will need a water color palette (they come in plastic or metal). It is always a good idea to have extra jar tops, saucers or Tupperware lids for extra puddle mixing.
- Other supplies: A plastic water jar
 1. A roll of toilet paper
 2. A roll of drafting tape

This list is just meant to get you started. After a few classes, you may decide to add to this list.
