


I Can... Visit Lightscape

I am going to **Lightscape** at the Chicago Botanic Garden.





This is an outdoor light show that happens at night from November to January. It might be cold, rainy, or snowy when I visit Lightscape.



I'll be sure to wear warm layers so that I will be comfortable the whole visit. I can wear a hat, gloves, a coat, or scarf if it is cold or bring an umbrella or raincoat if it is raining.



Lots of people visit Lightscape each year, which means it may be crowded during my visit. They may be gathered at the entrance as we arrive. My group will scan our tickets at the booth before entering.





There is one path for Lightscape. I will follow the path and stay with my group.





Because there is one path, the paths can also be crowded as people wait their turn to see certain light displays. I will wait my turn with my group.






At Lightscape, there will be lots of different lights to see, some of which may flash, blink, or move.



I can bring my own sunglasses to wear if the lights are too bright or cover my eyes.



Many of the light displays also have different music playing. This music can sometimes be loud.



I can cover my ears, wear earmuffs, or bring headphones from home to wear if the volume is too loud.



Some lights dangle down along the path for guests to walk through. If I do not want to touch or walk through the lights, I can take the path around the hanging lights to continue to the next display.





Along the way, I can stop with my group to take pictures.





I may stop with my group to get a snack or a drink at the **Rose** Garden, Evening Island, or Nichols Hall.



I could even get a hot chocolate or a s'more!



If I need to leave the Lightscape path, I can tell someone in my group so we can talk to a Chicago Botanic Garden staff member to find an exit.



Chicago Botanic Garden staff wear reflective vests and have red wands and radios so we can find them.



When I reach the end of the Lightscape path, it will be time to go home. We'll find our car in the parking lot and say goodbye!
